
The ASAM Treatment of Opioid Use Disorder Course FREE DATA WAIVER TRAINING



DESCRIPTION

The ASAM Treatment of Opioid Use Disorder Course covers all evidence-based practices and medications for treating patients with opioid use disorder.

COURSE FORMAT: 8 HOURS LIVE

This training satisfies eight hours of education requirements for providers to qualify for a DEA DATA2000 waiver. Upon completion of this course, physicians qualify for the waiver to prescribe buprenorphine in an office-based setting. NPs and PAs can qualify after completing an additional I6 hours provided by ASAM, the American Association of Nurse Practitioners, and the American Academy of PAs.
