

Provides the patient with the purpose of the SUD screening tool												
Provide SUD counseling to patients that score: •Eow risk – provide affirmation and education •Et risk – provide brief intervention •Eroblem use – provide brief intervention and follow up •Etkely dependent – referral												
Gives the patient a Screening tool to fill out for SDoH												
Provides the patient with the purpose of the SDoH screening tool												
Provides counsel to the patient on SDoH												
Triages patient calls related to SUD												
Completes the Intake Checklist												
Creates the medication treatment plan												
Initiates the treatment plan with the patient												
Provides patient education on buprenorphine safety												
Provides patient education on naloxone												
Provides patient education on monitoring side effects when tapering off of opioids												
Triages patient calls related to tapering side effects												
Determines the treatment plan when side effects present												
Conducts the intake assessment for patients with SUD												
Obtain written consent to share information on SUD with other providers												
Reviews with the patient the frequency and expectations of treatment for SUD												
Arranges/coordinates counseling services for the patient with SUD												
Obtains urine for toxicology screening												
Interprets the toxicology screening

Creates, monitors the use of, and or updates the induction protocol for MAT												
Discusses the induction plan with the patient and addresses any												
questions or knowledge gaps												
Obtains or completes the prescription for MAT												
Sends the prescription to the pharmacy												
Schedules the patient for induction therapy												
Day 1 of induction - assesses the patients level of withdrawal from opioids using the COWS or other tool												
Day 1 induction in the office - supervises the patient for												
medication administration, and educates the patient on												
technique (sublingual/buccal)												
Reassesses the patient after 30-60 minutes, instructs to then take their second dose of 2-4 mg as directed if needed, again observed and supervised												
Provides written instructions, establishes follow-up plan including												
same-day telephone check-in and clinic visits												
Determines if patients are acceptable candidates for home induction with buprenorphine/naloxone												
For home induction - provides written and verbal information												
about the program induction policies, COWS, and medication safety prior to determined home induction date												
After provision of information, uses methods to confirm the patient's understanding, such as teach back												
Follows up with the patient weekly, more or less as clinically												
indicated, to monitor and support the patient during treatment												
Determines if the patient is a good candidate for Naltrexone												
Assesses risk factors for Naltrexone (Cirrhosis, pregnancy,												
Breastfeeding, anemia/Thrombocytopenia, obesity/large body habitus, etc.)												
Addresses with the patient concerns on substance use during treatment												
Refers the patient to a higher level of care if intensified												
treatment does not resolve the substance use												
For patients referred to a higher level of care, review with the		·										
patient the reason and addresses any concerns questions												
Provides a warm handoff to the providers at the agency/program												
the patient has been referred to												
Addresses concerns of diversion with the patient to include												
patient input, concerns, and questions
