SBAR – Case Presentation Tool	
S	Situation: 50 y/o married, unemployed, Caucasian female. Presented for admission to detox for alcohol withdrawal. Drinking >30+ drinks per day. Actively withdrawing from alcohol and meth upon initial visit. She is slender, timid, guarded, restless, irritable, highly anxious, and watchful. "Never had any consequences...I can't be here anymore."
B	Background: Raised in chaotic, verbally aggressive family. Lives with husband (AUD), who is physically and emotionally abusive. Drinking escalated after in response to abuse. Recent job loss related to alcohol. Tearful/ashamed about inability to maintain responsibilities in her home. History of OUD.
A	Assessment: Alcohol/Meth/Opioid/Tobacco Use Disorders Active Trauma (rule out PTSD) MDD Requires medically monitored alcohol detox
R	Recommendation OR Question: How do you build trust/engage somebody after family intervention? How would you approach an encounter with her? How do you begin to explore/resolve ambivalence? How might you respond to her comment in first box? What barriers might our detox unit pose for her?
