

ASAM Training Registration Process

ASAM course registration process is a **two-step process**:

1. Create an ASAM Account
If you already have an ASAM account, you can skip to step 2.
2. Register for the Course/Training

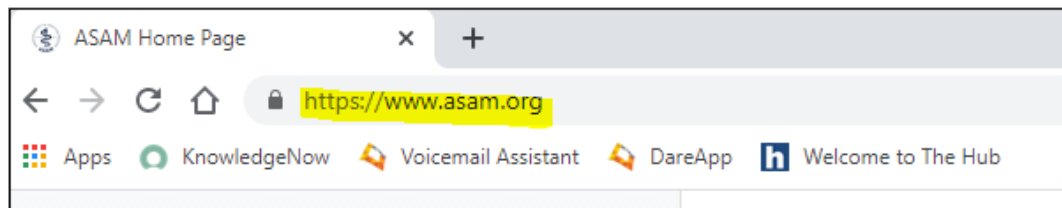
ASAM recommends Google Chrome to access ASAM courses, but Edge or Firefox will also work. Click the link below to download Google Chrome:

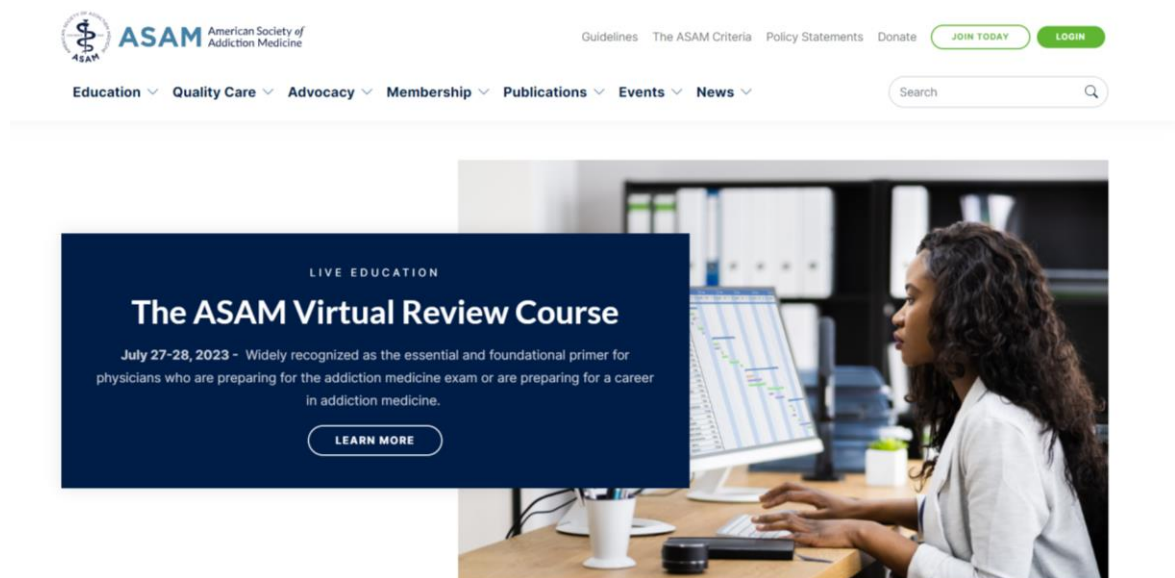
Step 1: Create Account

Please follow the steps below:

1. Copy/Paste the link below into the URL bar of your browser:
<https://www.asam.org/>



2. Once you are on the ASAM home page click **LOGIN** in the top, righthand corner:



3. After you click LOGIN, you are taken to the LOGIN page. Scroll down the page, read the instructions, and click **Create Account**:

When you click "Create Account" below, you will be redirected to a form where you will enter:

1. First Name
2. Last Name
3. A valid email address you wish to associate with your ASAM Online account and will serve as your username (double-check to ensure there are no typos)
4. A password of your own creation, which must meet have at least eight characters in total, one lower-case letter, one upper-case letter and one number one special character (like "?", "#", "%", etc.)
5. You will then be directed to the multi-page ASAM portal form where you will fill in more information like your name, address, company, etc. You must allow cookies to continue.
6. Once you have completed the ASAM portal form, you can opt to sign up for a membership or go directly to your portal home screen ("Return to Home").
7. Once you're at your portal home screen, click the ASAM logo in the upper left to direct you to the ASAM.org home page. Click "Login". Log in with the username and password you just created. You are now fully signed into the system and can access the e-Learning Center and, if you are a qualified member, the Journal of Addiction Medicine.
8. After you create an account, you will receive a verification email from MemberSuite Support. Please click the verification link provided to confirm your account. The link will expire in 7 days.

To create a new ASAM account, you will need to enter a username, email address and password. Your username **MUST** match your email address and your password must meet all the requirements listed below.



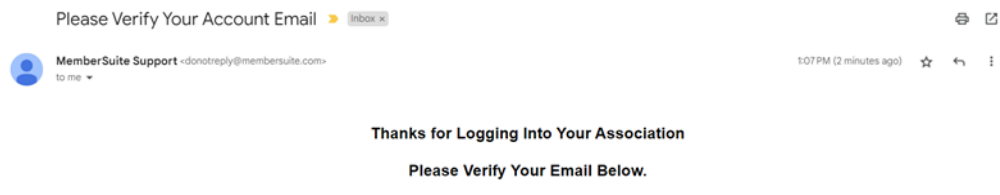

7. Click **Verify Email**. You will be redirected to a page with the message below:

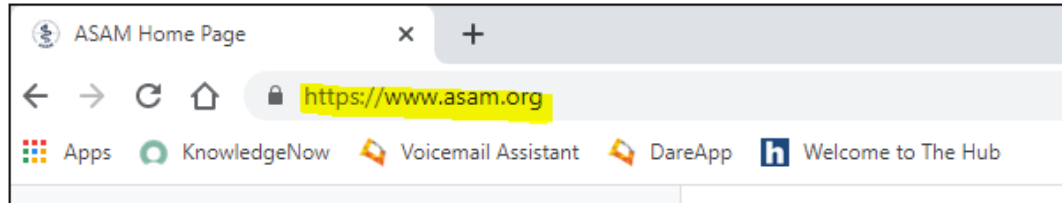

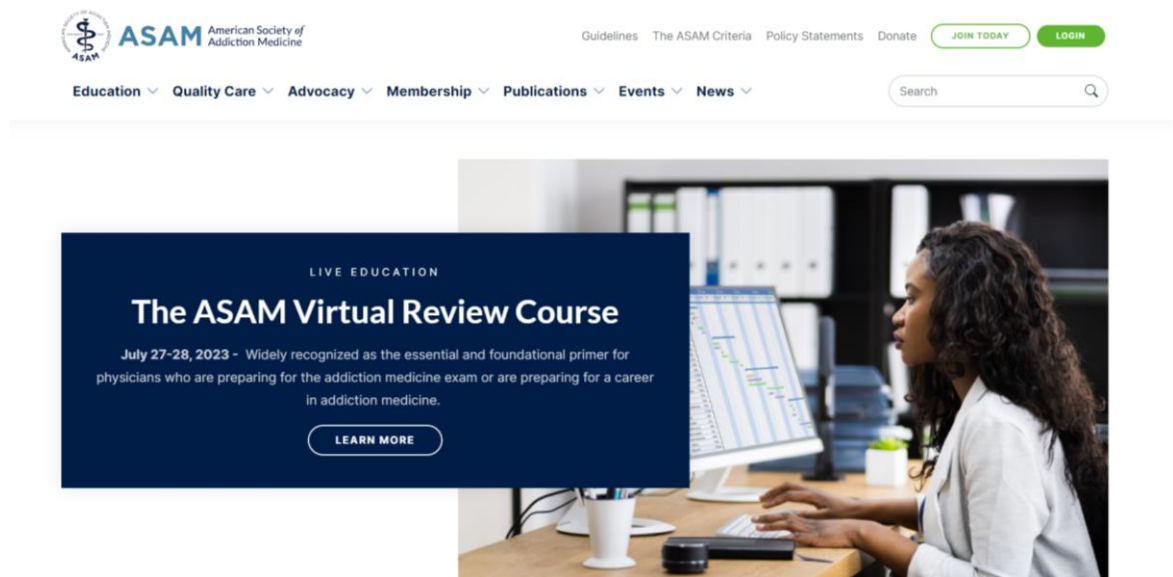
Step 2: Registering for a Course

Treatment of Opioid Use Disorder Course

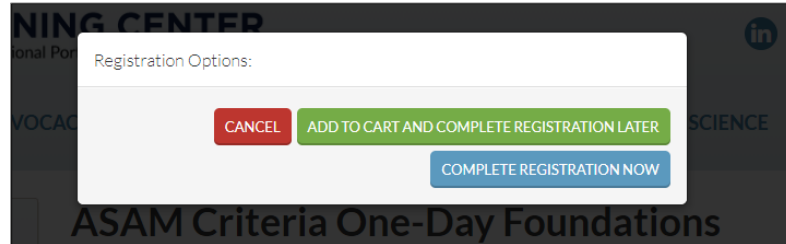

Overview

The ASAM Treatment of Opioid Use Disorder Course provides eight hours of education essential for providers to identify, assess, diagnose, and manage the treatment of patients with opioid use disorder (OUD). Through interactive and application-focused learning experiences, participants will explore misconceptions, stigma, and complexities associated with OUD and the use of medications to treat OUD, as well as how to address it for policies, systems, providers, and patients. Participants will gain an understanding of the epidemiology and neurobiology of opioid use disorder as well as opioid pharmacology, with a focus on medication-first treatment of OUD. Participants will examine medication and psychosocial treatment options and best practices for initiating and maintaining the treatment of OUD in hospital, office-based, and other outpatient settings. Emphasizing harm reduction or outcome-directed care, this course equips participants with the knowledge and skills to develop a low-threshold
